The Art Competition is hosted annually by the House of Representatives to recognize and showcase the artistic achievement of our nation's high school students.

All high school students grades 9–12 residing in the 5th District counties of Cherokee, Chester, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lancaster, Lee, Union, York, and parts of Spartanburg and Sumter counties who attend private, public, or who are part of the home school network can submit their work. Entries will begin being accepted mid-April.

Following the decision of a panel of judges, each district's winning piece of art will be displayed in a year-long exhibit in the U.S. Capitol and the winner will receive an invitation to view the exhibit in Washington, D.C. in June 2024.
