



ABOUT MAJ. CAPERS

As the recipient of a Silver Star, two Bronze Stars with "V" for valor, and three Purple Hearts, Maj. James Capers, Jr. is one of the most decorated Marines in Force Reconnaissance history. Rep. Ralph Norman has filed a bill in the House of Representatives, H.R. 587, to authorize the President to award the Medal of Honor to Maj. Capers for acts of valor during the Vietnam War.
