- 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several

- 2 for ratification:
- 3 "Article —
- 4 "Section 1. A Representative or Senator may not
- 5 receive compensation with respect to any period during
- 6 which a Government shutdown is in effect. For purposes
- 7 of this article, a Government shutdown shall be considered
- 8 to be in effect if there is a lapse in appropriations for any
- 9 Federal agency or department as a result of a failure to
- 10 enact a regular appropriations bill or continuing resolu-
- 11 tion.
- "Section 2. Congress shall have the power to en-
- 13 force this article through appropriate legislation.".
